### **Accessibility Reviews**

 a) Application for Site Plan Approval, SPC-945, 540 Brealey Drive (Proposed construction of a two storey 19 unit residential apartment building and 14 Townhomes.)

Presented by Neil Campbell, Aside Architects

Neil Campbell presented the relevant information and drawings.

#### **Summary of recommendations from the Built Environment Sub-Committee:**

- 1. Extend elevator to the storage units in the residential apartment building.
- 2. Add a ramp from the storage level to the grade at the rear of the residential apartment building.
- 3. Provide secure storage in mechanical room of the residential apartment building for 3 scooters with charging options; in addition to the charging options on the ground floor outside of the residential apartment building.
- 4. Unit 109 and Unit 209 of the residential apartment building include a Juliette balcony.
- 5. The accessible washroom off the amenity room of the residential apartment building include an adult change table.
- 6. Include a pedestrian link to Brealey Drive multi-use trail.
- 7. Include demarcation on driveway to the church property for pedestrian travel. Provide tactile attention indicators where required.
- 8. Provide adequate lighting on pedestrian walkways and accessible parking spots to the entrance of the residential apartment building.
- 9. Include a sidewalk to serve the 14 townhomes.
- 10. Include a bench outside of residential apartment building near lighting.
- 11. Provide adequate turnaround space for Handi-Vans.

a) Accessibility Site Plan Checklists

Mark Buffone, Accessibility Compliance Coordinator presented examples of Accessibility Site Plan Checklists from neighbouring municipalities.

Staff will prepare a draft Accessibility Site Plan Checklist for committee. Staff will refer to past accessibility site plan recommendations to for reoccurring themes and issues.
