Canoe Museum Update Presentation

Purpose

A report to receive a presentation from the Canadian Canoe Museum as an update on its capital construction plans.

Recommendation

That the update presentation, by Richard Tucker from the Canadian Canoe Museum regarding the Museum's Reinvention/Relocation project, be received for information.

Budget and Financial Implications

There are no budget or financial implications in receiving the report. In the City's 2016 Capital Budget (Reference 6-8.02), Council approved a \$100,000 contribution to the Canoe Museum as transition funding in support of this project.

Background

On June 23, 2014, as a result of Report CSD14-017, Richard Tucker, the Director of the Canadian Canoe Museum advised Council of the Canoe Museum's plans to relocate to the Peterborough Lift Lock site. He also provided Council with details on the Museum's spatial and development needs as outlined in its latest Feasibility Study.

At the upcoming meeting, Mr. Tucker will provide details on the Museum's recent decision to engage Dublin-based Heneghan Peng Architects to design the Canoe Museum's proposed new home. He will share details of their winning proposal and outline next steps in the development process.
