• Group responsible for 1 year financial support, 1 year settlement support, 1 year social support


GAR – Government Assisted Refugee

- Government responsible for 1 year financial support
- NCC responsible for essential settlement support
- No extended settlement or social support
- IRCC Immigration, Refugees and Citizenship Canada
- RAP Resettlement Assistance Program

Rough Timeline (Sept. – Feb.)

- Hub for sponsoring groups
- NCC Board decisions
- Contact point for IRCC
- Coordination of Refugee Resettlement Task Force
- Contact and liaison for media
- Reception of family linked GARs
- Formation of support groups for GARs
- Continual work with PSR's
- •Resettlement Assistance Program (RAP) proposal submitted
- Projection of April to receive GARs via RAP

Clarifications from Report

- Arrivals; 8 PSR families, 3 GAR families
- Have now submitted RAP application to IRCC
- Current submission is 3 GAR families per month, brought down from 6; conversation with IRCC
- Numbers of 250-500 should now be read as ~30
 PSR families and ~36 GAR families.
- Housing Resource Centre also working with PSR groups, not just GARs.



Clarifications from Report

- ESL working group has now been formed
- Not just 20 GAR support groups; goal is to have as many support groups as there are GAR families arriving.
- Already have 18 support groups (many fully formed)
- Additional information session this Thu Feb 18th

- •Meet immediate settlement needs (e.g. OHIP)
- Orientation workshops
- Assist with permanent housing search
- Work with support groups, sponsorship groups, community partners, and other volunteers

Role of Support Groups

- Social connections and fun activities
- Orientation to Community
- Transportation and scheduling
- Assist with permanent housing search
- Assist with move to permanent housing
- Work with community partners
- *Police checks mandatory
