1.0 PURPOSE

- To provide a City-wide Asset Management framework that enables a coordinated, costeffective, and sustainable approach to the management of the City's Assets in order to:
 - Facilitate effective decision-making and risk management related to management of the .1 City's Assets.
 - Meet new legislative and regulatory requirements. .2
 - Maintain or enhance levels of service. .3
 - Improve Asset efficiency, effectiveness, and sustainability. .4
 - .5 Accommodate growth and changing demographics.

2.0 POLICY STATEMENT(S)

- The City shall adopt ISO 55000 series of standards, and its amendments, as the guiding standards for the development of the City's Asset Management framework.
- The City's Asset Management framework and related activities shall comply with all applicable 2.2 laws and regulations.

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2.0 POLICY STATEMENT(S)

- 2.3 The City commits to:
 - .1 Demonstrate effective use of Stakeholder funds through the objective evaluation of Asset Management investment needs.
 - .2 Ensure that Asset Management objectives align with key City plans and strategies.
 - .3 Ensure the objective evaluation and management of infrastructure risks.
 - .4 Continuously improve its Asset Management practices and long-term capital budget vision through internal and external Asset Management Program audits.
 - .5 Collaborate with internal and external stakeholders related to Asset Management planning and decision-making.
 - .6 Develop Asset Management objectives with respect to City services provided through City infrastructure.
 - .7 Review this Policy every five years or in response to any significant changes.

3.0 APPLICATION

- 3.1 This Policy applies to all City-owned Assets and activities related to City Assets, excluding assets owned by CoPHI and PUC.
- 3.2 This Policy applies to all those responsible for or involved in delivering services through the City's assets.

Asset - As defined by the ISO 55000 standards package, an item, thing, or entity that has potential or actual value to the City.

Asset Management - As defined by the ISO 55000 standards package, the coordinated activity of an organization to realize value from assets.

City - The Corporation of the City of Peterborough.

ISO 55000 - The internationally recognized standard in Asset Management.

Stakeholder - People or organizations that can affect, be affected by a decision with respect to a service.

Activities - actions related to the actions taken to manage assets. These include operations, maintenance, rehabilitation, renewal and planning.

Service - The benefits gained by the stakeholders through our assets.
