With so much to be proud of, it is no wonder that people in Peterborough are the happiest in Ontario! Come and experience it for yourself, choose Peterborough to be your new home!



Why new Canadians are flocking to Peterborough


City offers high quality-of-life and resources for working professionals

Becky Rogers doesn't hesitate when describing what makes Peterborough, Ont. the ideal place to live: enjoying a high quality of life, a non-existent rush hour (it's "rush minutes," if anything), vibrant food and arts scenes, awe-inspiring parks and easy access to Toronto and Ottawa. At the top of Rogers' list is Peterborough's welcoming atmosphere, which, she says, truly values the skills, experience and knowledge of

"When I talk to newcomers who have been here a while, they often tell me the same thing I've experienced when I travel: After being away, they always look forward to coming home," says Rogers, who in her role as manager of the city's arts, culture and

in 2016, Peterborough welcomed 826 people from 79 countries, including 300 Syrian refugees. To support its newcomer community, the city offers diverse resources such as the New Canadians Centre, Peterborough Immigration Partnership's Community Integration Plan and the WelcomsPeterborough sa portal, says Rogers.

The portal launched in 2010 and covers information relevant to entrepreneurs, international students or others who are considering moving to Peterborough or have recently arrived. It is currently undergoing a redesign and will go live in June.

"The updated site will have new interactive features and be mobile friendly," says Rogers. 'This is important as many people from other regions of the world rely on their smart phones to access the Internet. We want to ensure everyone has access to the information on WelcomePaterborough.ca."

Thanks to the portal and the area's business community (entities including the local Chambers of Commerce, business network groups and funding organizations); immigrants in Palarhorough have thrived. In 2012, the Conference Board of Canada reported that 35 per cent of new Canadians in Peterborough were self-employed — the highest rate of immigrant entrepreneurship in the country.

Rhonda Keanan is president and CEO of Poterborough and the Kawarthas Economic Development (PKED), A non-profit corporation, PKED is responsible for delivering aconomic development and tourism services on behalf of the City and County of Paterborough. She says the statistic is a talling one.

"This is a testament to both the collaborative and welcoming business environment and quality of life in the region," says Keenan. "Professionals from around the world are finding the support and resources that they need to succeed in our community."

A raport by the Martin Prosperity Institute, meanwhile, raveals Peterborough is one of Canada's most inventive cities with more than 30 per cent of its labour force employed in creative economy occupations, By 2020, says the report, this number will increase by 23 per cent. Rogers says the shift is part of the transition the city is making away. from an industrial focus to a hub of creative enterprises, entrepreneurship, startups and

With the transition, says Stuart Harrison, president and CEO of the Greater Peterborough Chamber of Commerce, Peterborough continually looks to the global

"Businesses in the Paterborough area are hungry for trained employees," he says. "Accessing international talent in a timely manner can be effective way of filling a job opening. Peterborough has a strong support system in place to make those

And, adds Rogers, international students who attend local institutions. Trent University and Florning College, are increasingly playing an important role in this.
