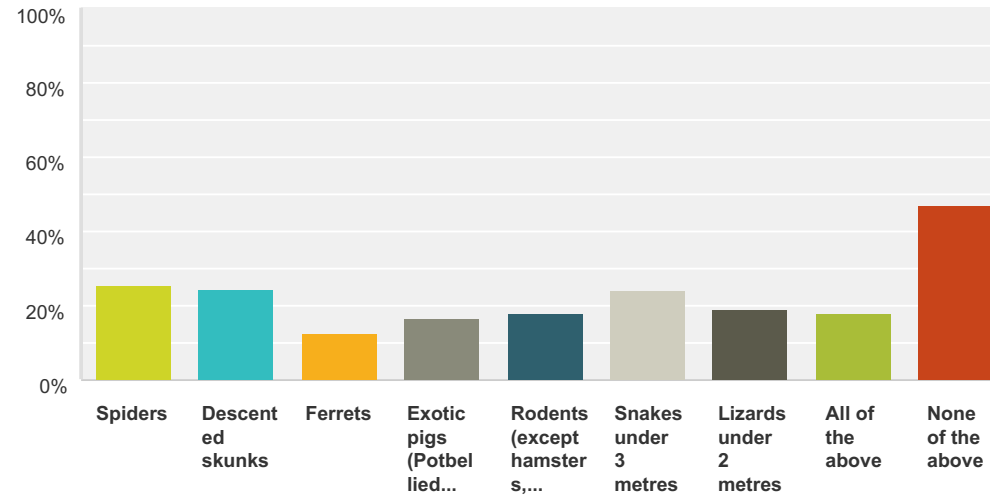

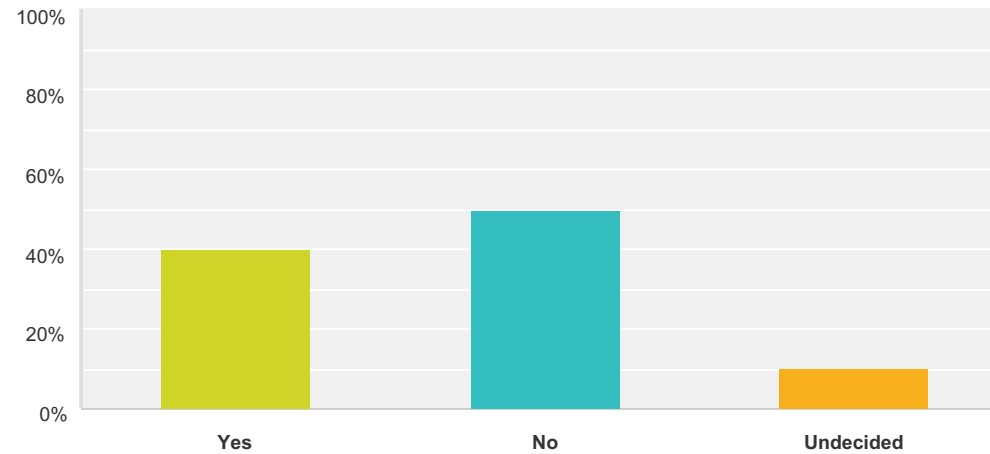

Q2 Should the City continue to limit the number of restricted animals to 3 per species?

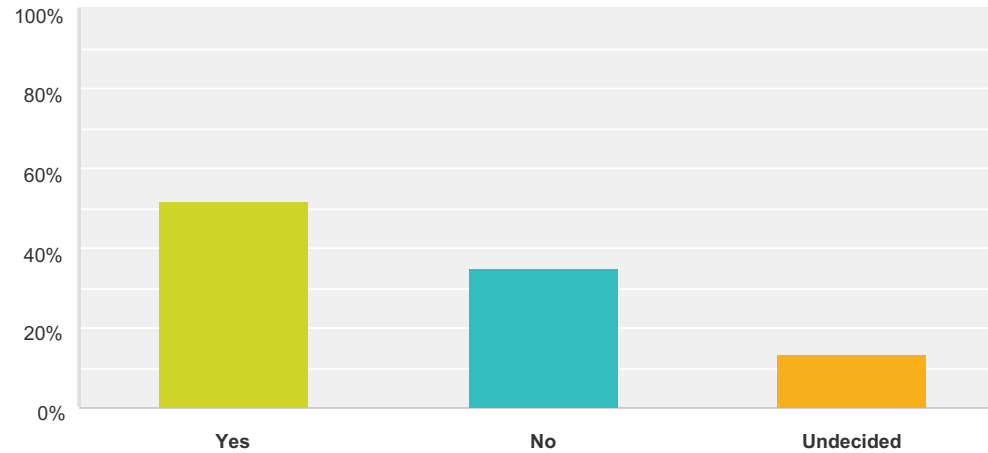

Q3 Should the City consider revising the Animal By-law (16-079) to allow exemptions for breeders of restricted animals?

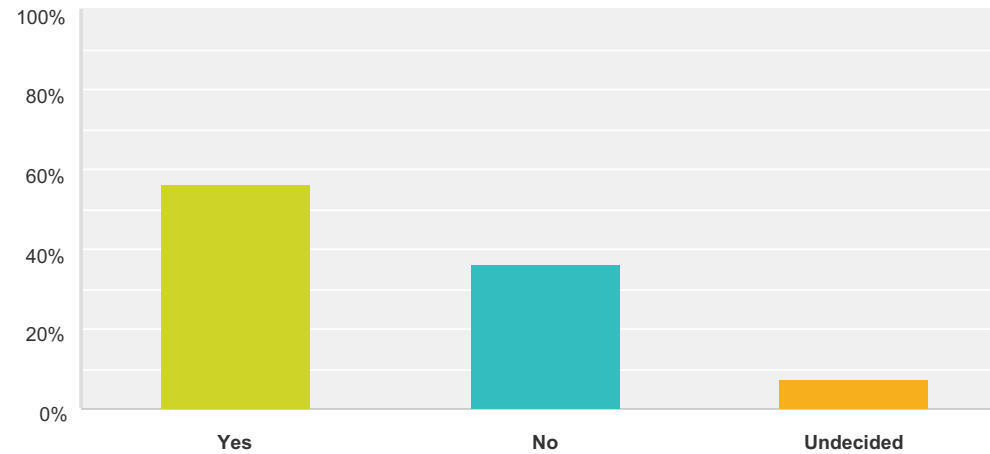

Q4 Should the City continue to require owners of restricted animals to obtain an annual permit for each animal?

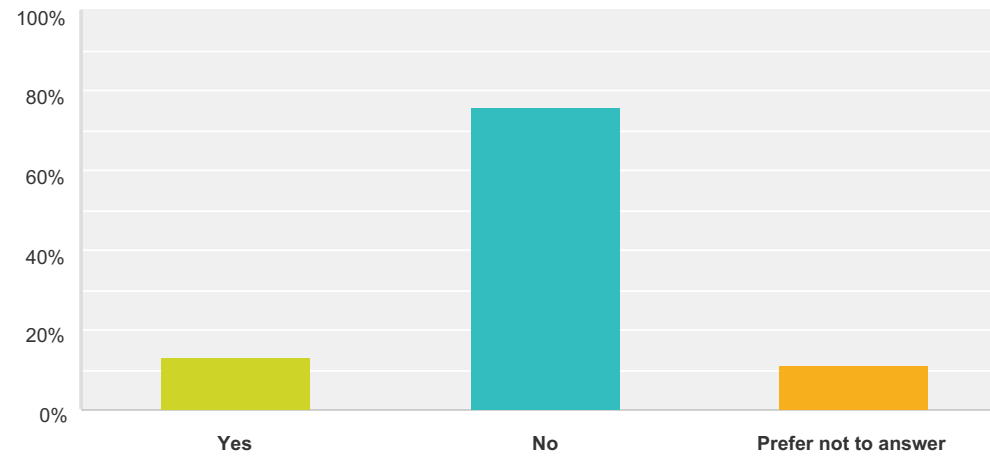

Q5 Do you currently keep restricted animals in the City of Peterborough?

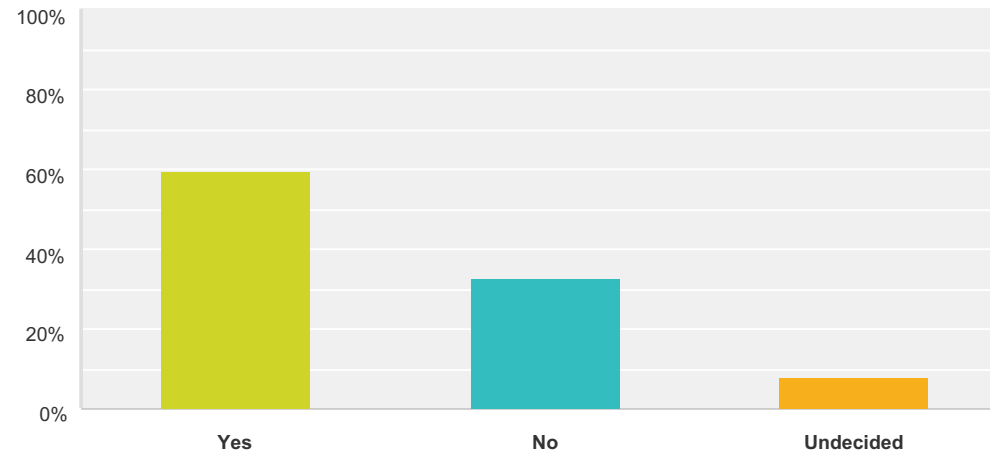
