## Background

Following the adoption of the Greater Peterborough Area Community Sustainability Plan in April 2012, sustainable projects and initiatives have taken off. Each year the Chair of Sustainable Peterborough and the Sustainable Peterborough Coordinator present an annual update to each of the twelve community partners, including the City of Peterborough, the County of Peterborough, and the eight local Townships, Curve Lake First Nation and Hiawatha First Nation. They are each justifiably proud of their local initiatives and accomplishments, and continue to vow to do even better the following year.

Over 400 items were recorded on the Sustainable Peterborough website for 2014, but it is not just the volume that is impressive, it is the depth and breadth of sustainable initiatives across the Greater Peterborough Area.

Sustainable Peterborough has also helped to forge a strong regional partnership among the member municipalities, First Nations, organizations, businesses, and community groups. This framework of collaboration continues through the development of the Greater Peterborough Area Climate Change Action Plan, through the Sustainable Peterborough Working Groups, and stakeholder engagement.

As part of the Sustainability Plan, the Sustainable Peterborough Coordinating Committee has committed to sharing our annual community accomplishments through the presentation of the 2014 Annual Report Card.
