Q17&18 - budgets do not include expenses related to memberships, subscriptions, or traveling to conferences etc. The budget amounts in 17 and 18 are for expenses in their respective wards.

Q19&20 - benefits are optional. If councillors or Mayor want dental, health, vision, they have to pay 50% of the cost personally. Life insurance is provided.

Instead, the City will make a contribution to their individual RRSP's up to 13% of their salary (including the additional amount they receive in per diem compensation). The elected officials have to provide proof that they have the contribution room. In 2012, Members of Council voted to freeze their compensation at the 2011 level.
