- Provides referrals individuals looking for information on human and social services
- Publishes the Bluebook every two years
- Oversees the Emergency Volunteer Registry

- 385,628 searches for human social service info
- 43,721 searches for volunteer opportunities
- UW PTBO manages 1129 information records
