Cross King Street and bear left to Distillery Street.

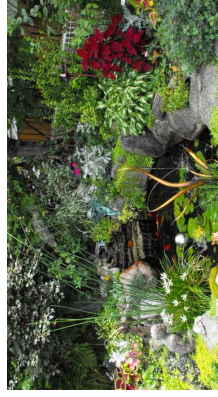
Secret Garden Tour and Gourd Decorating
