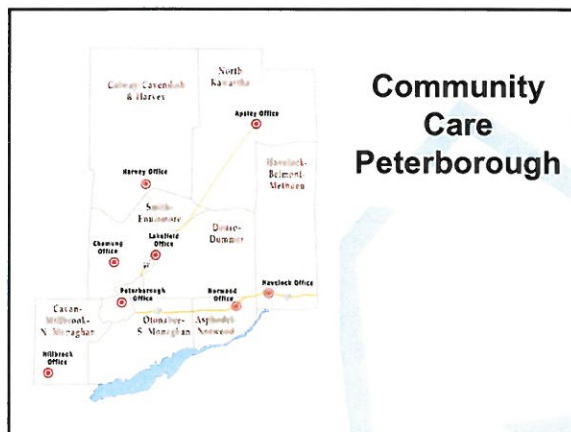

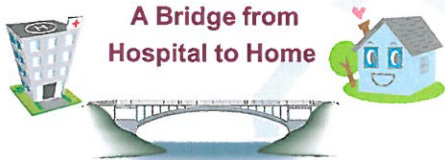
A philosophy that promotes safe and timely care, services and supports to meet health care needs of patients and families.
