Subject:	Report AAC18-014 New Play Structure on McNamara Road

## **Purpose**

A report to inform the Accessibility Advisory Committee and the Arenas Parks and Recreation Advisory Committee of the development of City owned parkland at 2034 McNamara Road through a presentation by Basterfield and Associates Inc. on behalf of the Ontario Federation of Anglers and Hunters (OFAH).

## Recommendations

That the Accessibility Advisory Committee (AAC) approve the recommendations outlined in Report AAC18-014 dated April 4, 2018 of the Accessibility and Communication Specialist as follows:

- a) That the presentation by Basterfield and Associates be received for information; and
- b) That the AAC provide comments on and endorse the proposed park design elements.

## **Budget and Financial Implications**

There are no budgetary or financial implications associated with the recommendation. The OFAH is responsible for all costs associated with the development of the parkland.

## Background

On September 12, 2016, Council approved the recommendations of Report PLPD16-063, authorizing the purchase of the property at 2034 McNamara Road, and to enter a Stewardship agreement with OFAH. The City and Federation may, in partnership, carry out improvements to the property that reflect a City-wide recreational/open space.

Staff have invited OFAH to attend the April 4, 2018 meeting of the AAC to present the proposed concept design for the park amenities, and to seek input from the AAC.

The members of the Arenas Parks and Recreation Advisory Committee have been invited to attend the AAC meeting on April 4, 2018 as a mechanism to share the information with both Advisory Committees.
