Seasonal Closing

Purpose

A report to advise the Library Board concerning the seasonal closing of the library on December 28, 2015.

Recommendations

That the Peterborough Public Library Board of Trustees approve the recommendations outlined in Report PPL15-019 dated December 1, 2015, of the Library Manager/CEO, as follows:

- a) That the motion passed at the October 27, 2015 Board of Trustees meeting regarding seasonal library hours be rescinded, and
- b) That the Peterborough Public Library Board select option #3, to remain open over Christmas.

Budget and Financial Implications

There are direct financial implications depending on the option chosen.

Background

At the previous Library Board Meeting the Board was advised by City staff and the CEO/Library Manager that the library would close to the public on December 28, 2015 to be in-line with the rest of the City of Peterborough closure. This was incorrect, and the City of Peterborough has not agreed to pay for the associated fees. As a result a new motion must be passed to approve the revised library hours.

Traditionally the library closes at 5:00 pm on the Monday after Christmas.
