Library CEO Report November 2017

Purpose

A report to inform the Library Board of Trustees on general matters concerning Library operations and services.

Budget and Financial Implications

Background

Staffing update

Colleen Allen, Library Services Technician, has announced her retirement after 40 plus years with the Library. There will be a retirement party held at the DelaFosse in December to celebrate her long career.

Collection

A brief one question survey was conducted at the circulation desk over the course of seven non-consecutive days in October. Patrons were asked at check out "What format do you use to watch movies and television shows: Blu-ray, DVD, 4K Ultra HD Blu-ray, and/or streaming (i.e. Netflix)?" The purpose of this survey was to determine if the library should establish a physical Blu-ray collection.

The initial goal was to gather feedback from 300 library patrons. The actual number surveyed in the end was 200 inside the library and 36 through Twitter. Due to the formatting constraints of Twitter, the survey question was slightly different than the inhouse survey. The Twitter survey was conducted on a single day in October.

At this point, it does not appear that the library should invest resources in establishing a Blu-ray collection, but rather should continue to maintain its DVD collection and its online streaming options to continue supporting our users.

Staff have been working on cataloguing the backlog of microfilm and adding reels to our collection. At the time of this report there remains only 10 more records to create. Once completed, all of the Examiner and Peterborough this Week reels will be searchable in our catalogue.

Staff have completed tagging more than 85% of our collection with the new inventory system. The last items we have left to tag include the more complicated mix material kits, and the items at DelaFosse. We are on schedule to complete the tagging before the move back to Aylmer St.

Partnerships

The Library has been approached by a representative of the Downie-Wenjack Fund Legacy Room project. There is the possibility for the Peterborough Public Library to be a "Legacy Place":

"A Legacy Room is a space within an organization dedicated to reconciliation and showcases an organization's commitment to our collective reconciliation journey. It is meant to be a place where conversations about reconciliation are encouraged and serves as a constant reminder for employees, clients and guests of your organization's commitment to reconciliation."

Staff also attended the Senior's Summit at Trent to promote library services.
