## **Purpose**

## Background

By-Law 11-019, a By-Law to Establish a Museum and Archives Advisory Committee, was passed on February 22, 2011. Amendments to By-Law 11-019 were approved by the Museum and Archives Advisory Committee (MAAC13-004). Additionally, By-Law 16-027 includes minor wording changes to ensure consistency with Procedure By-Law 11-127.

Report CSACH16-002 will be reviewed by Committee of the Whole on March 7, 2016 (Appendix A). It is the intent that By-law 16-027, a By-Law to Establish a Museum and Archives Advisory Committee is attached (Appendix B), will be adopted by Council at their meeting on March 14, 2016.
