PURPOSE

BACKGROUND

The 2012 Canadian Association for Conservation of Cultural Property workshops and conference will be held in Peterborough, Ontario, May 22 to May 26. A two-day workshop, "Preservation Unplugged", will explore new trends in preventive conservation with an emphasis on facilities. A half day workshop on basket-making will be held at the Curve Lake Cultural Centre. The conference theme, the "Power of Preservation", will look at preservation aspects that highlight the significance, value, advocacy and interpretation of the tangible and intangible aspects of conservation.
