BACKGROUND

The Mandate of the Peterborough Museum & Archives (Museum) states "As part of the collective memory of the community, the Peterborough Museum & Archives preserves, presents and promotes the heritage and culture of Peterborough and area...". The research recently accomplished by Museum personnel contributes to the body of knowledge available regarding the city of Peterborough's namesake, the Honourable Peter Robinson.

The Curator and Education Officer will display and discuss recently acquired artifacts relating to ongoing research into Peter Robinson and his children, including rare family Bibles, a Baptismal mug, Fenian medal and hundreds of family letters.

SUMMARY

The Peter Robinson research contributes to the community's understanding of its heritage and the significance behind Peterborough's designation of the August Civic holiday as "Peter Robinson Day".
