### **Background**

Municipal Cultural Plan (2012), Strategic Direction #3: Strengthen Heritage, Recommendations, Action 3.1.3 "Commission a Conservation District Study" was identified for completion within 1 to 3 years (page 63). The City of Peterborough is currently undertaking its first Heritage Conservation District Study in the neighbourhood known in the community as the "Avenues". E.R.A. Architects (<a href="http://era.on.ca/">http://era.on.ca/</a>) have been hired to facilitate the Heritage Conservation District Study process. As part of the Study, the Heritage Preservation Office and ERA Architects have partnered with the Museum Management and Curatorship (MMC) program at Fleming College. MMC students and faculty have been working to complete historical research on properties within the study area.
