Phase 1 – **Complete** Procurement of required professional services (project managers, architects, contractors, et. al.) through fair and equitable City policies and procedures.

Phase 2 – In Progress Construction of new on-site storage facility.

Phase 3 – **Complete** Relocation of artifact and archival collections to temporary, off-site storage.

Phase 4 – In Progress Renovation of lower level.

Throughout all phases of the Museum Renewal Project, the Museum will remain open to the public and will continue to: host new exhibitions, welcome school groups, operate camps and activities for children, host Fleming College's Museum Management & Curatorship program as well as provide facility rental services. The Archives closed to the public on Friday, December 20, 2013; it is anticipated the Archives will reopen in the fall of 2014.

Summary

The Peterborough Museum & Archives Renewal Project is moving forward, with the support of skilled and experienced leadership. The Project has been made possible through generous funding from the City of Peterborough and the Department of Canadian Heritage.
