Draft Official Plan Review

Purpose

A report to recommend that the PACAC review proposed changes to the heritage section of the Official Plan.

Recommendations

That the PACAC approve the recommendations outlined in Report PACAC16-017, dated May 5, 2016 of the Heritage Resources Coordinator, as follows:

- a) That the PACAC undertake a formal review of the proposed amendments to the Official Plan as they relate to heritage, and;
- b) That the Chair be directed to provide comment to the Planning Division based on the review by the Committee.

Budget and Financial Implications

There are no budgetary or financial implications associated with this recommendation.

Background

In 2012, an ad-hoc committee of the PACAC was convened to research and provide recommendations on appropriate heritage content as part of the City's review and update of the Official Plan (OP). The Committee undertook a scan of OPs across Ontario and produced a comprehensive brief which was approved by the PACAC and provided to the Planning Division (Appendix A). The submission provided has helped to inform the current draft of the Official Plan that is now publicly available for review and comment.

Drawing on the comments initially provided in 2012, and subsequent material provided by HPO staff, it is recommended that the PACAC undertake to review the draft amendments to the Official Plan as they relate to heritage.
