Subject:	Report PACAC16-040 City Hall Elevator Project

Purpose

A report to recommend that the PACAC receive a presentation from Lett Architects and provide comment regarding the proposed design of the new elevator for the City Hall.

Recommendations

That the PACAC approve the recommendations outlined in Report PACAC16-040, dated November 3, 2016 of the Heritage Resources Coordinator, as follows:

- a) That the PACAC receive the presentation from Lett Architects regarding the proposed design for the City Hall elevator;
- b) That the PACAC approve, approve with conditions, or not approve the proposed alteration to City Hall to accommodate the installation of a new elevator.

Background

In order to enhance accessibility at City Hall, a project is underway to install a new elevator in the lobby. The proposed design requires a structure on the roof of the building, which will be visible and will alter the existing roofline of a heritage structure designated under Part IV of the Ontario Heritage Act. Lett Architects will make a presentation on the proposed design.
