Subject: Report PACAC17-004
Cenotaph Advisory Committee Representation

Purpose

A report to recommend that the PACAC make the necessary appointments pertaining to representation on the Cenotaph Advisory Committee and a related joint ad-hoc committee.

Recommendations

That the Peterborough Architectural Conservation Advisory Committee approve the recommendations outlined in Report PACAC17-004, dated January 5, 2017 of the Heritage Resources Coordinator, as follows:

- a) That the PACAC appoint a representative to serve on the Cenotaph Advisory Committee for 2017;
- b) That the PACAC appoint one additional member to serve on a joint ad-hoc committee between the Peterborough Architectural Conservation Advisory Committee and the Cenotaph Advisory Committee.

Budget and Financial Implications

There are no budgetary or financial implications associated with the recommendation.

Background

In accordance with By-law 10-025, the composition of the Cenotaph Advisory Committee shall include “One member of the City’s municipal heritage committee (“PACAC”) as recommended by the membership of PACAC.” This recommendation is made annually by the PACAC in January.

On October 6, 2016, the PACAC received for information a presentation from Cenotaph Advisory Committee representatives regarding proposed alterations to the Citizens’ War Memorial. Following the presentation, the PACAC passed the following motion:

“That PACAC propose a joint ad-hoc committee between the Peterborough Architectural Conservation Advisory Committee and the Cenotaph Advisory Committee” to further review the proposed alterations to the Citizens’ War Memorial.

It was determined that the appointment of PACAC representatives to this ad-hoc committee would be deferred to 2017. In addition to the newly appointed representative of the PACAC on the Cenotaph Advisory Committee for 2017, one other member should be appointed to serve on the ad-hoc committee.
