Review of Heritage Impact Assessment - 266 Burnham St.

Purpose

A report to recommend that the PACAC receive the Heritage Impact Assessment for 266 Burnham Street and provide comment.

Recommendations

That the Peterborough Architectural Conservation Advisory Committee approve the recommendations outlined in Report PACAC17-010, dated February 2, 2017 of the Heritage Resources Coordinator, as follows:

- a) That the Heritage Impact Assessment for 266 Burnham Street as prepared by ERA Architects, Inc. be received for information; and
- b) That the PACAC provide comment on the recommendations in the assessment.

Budget and Financial Implications

There are no budgetary or financial implications associated with the recommendation.

Background

At the November meeting of the PACAC the committee received a presentation on the proposed severance of property from 266 Burnham St. to create two new building lots.

The committee felt that there was a need to consider the implications of the application on the heritage attributes of the property and subsequently passed a motion that a Heritage Impact Assessment (HIA) be undertaken as a condition of provisional approval by the Committee of Adjustment and further that a Site Plan Agreement be created and approved by the Planner, Urban Design and the Heritage Resources Coordinator as a condition of approval by the Committee of Adjustment

The property owner retained ERA Architects to undertake the assessment and a draft is being provided to the committee for its review and comment.
