Appointment of a PACAC member to the Cenotaph Advisory Committee

PURPOSE

A report to request that the PACAC select a committee member to appoint to the Cenotaph Advisory Committee (CAC).

RECOMMENDATION

That the PACAC approve Report PACAC10-017, dated May 11, 2010, of the Heritage Resources Coordinator, as follows:

That the Committee selects a member to serve as on the Cenotaph Advisory Committee.

BUDGET AND FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

There are no budget or financial implications associated with the recommendation.

BACKGROUND

At the March 1, 2010 Meeting of City Council, By-Law 10-025 was passed creating a Cenotaph Precinct encompassing the Cenotaph and the soon to be erected Veterans Wall of Honour. The by-law stipulates that the City will create a Cenotaph Advisory Committee to oversee the use of the Cenotaph Precinct. The composition of the Committee includes a member of PACAC. The length of term of service on the CAC by a member of the PACAC is left to the discretion of the committee. It is therefore recommended that the PACAC select one member to serve on the Cenotaph Advisory Committee and determine the length of service for that position.
