PURPOSE

A report to recommend that the PACAC consider organizing a tour of historic homes or structures in the fall of 2012.

BUDGET AND FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

BACKGROUND

The Historic House Tours could generate some revenue through the sale of PACAC 'swag', or through sale of passes or admission to each site. Revenue generated could be used to fund heritage workshops for the public and for designated heritage property owners. The tour could include some of Peterborough's oldest buildings, with a focus on stone construction.
