Lily Lake Functional Planning Study Presentation

BUDGET AND FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

There are no budget or financial implications resulting from the approval of the recommendation of Report PACAC12-009.

BACKGROUND

A presentation will be made by Brad Appleby regarding the Lily Lake Functional Planning Study now underway. The development of these lands could have a profound effect on the natural and cultural heritage landscape of the Jackson Creek basin.

Under the Ontario heritage Act, Council can designate areas as cultural heritage landscapes and protect land from development that would adversely impact the attributes of the cultural landscape. This process is being used to good effect in Ontario to protect view sheds like those experienced from the Jackson Park trail. The presentation from the Planning Division will provide a good background from which the PACAC may begin a discussion about the possibilities of cultural landscape designation.
