Commemoration for Martha Kidd

PURPOSE

A report to propose that a commemoration of the life of Martha Kidd be undertaken by the PACAC.

RECOMMENDATION

That the PACAC approve the recommendation outlined in Report PACAC12-032, dated September 11, 2012 of the Heritage Resources Coordinator, as follows:

That the contributions to the preservation of Peterborough's heritage by Martha Ann Kidd be remembered through the creation of a public commemoration by the PACAC.

BACKGROUND

Martha Kidd passed away on July 30, 2012 at the age of 94. Martha was a founding member of the PACAC and a tireless advocate for the preservation of heritage buildings in the City for nearly 50 years. She authored several books on the architectural heritage of the City and served on countless committees with the City and the Peterborough Historical Society. The HPO is recommending that the PACAC consider the creation of a lasting commemorative to reflect Martha's enduring legacy.
