Heritage Tree Program Update

PURPOSE

BACKGROUND

Peterborough Green-Up, in partnership with the City of Peterborough and the PACAC, has received Trillium Funding to support a Heritage Tree Project. The project consists of a number of initiatives including the Treasured Tree Hunt and Heritage Tree Designation policy development.

As part of the program, Green-Up would also like to conduct a historical recreation tree planting in Inverlea Park. The goals of this project include restoring the original biodiversity, favouring historically accurate species, and preserving the local gene pool where possible. The project will encourage public education through the creation of interpretive panels, outlining both the social and natural history of the park.

Through historical research, several tree species have been identified for planting.
