Plan-it Peterborough Process Update

PURPOSE

A report to introduce a presentation by the Planner of Subdivision Control and Special Projects on the current status of the Official Plan update.

BUDGET AND FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

There are no direct budget or financial implications resulting from this report.

BACKGROUND

On March 4, 2013 The Planning Division presented a report to Council on the Official Plan (OP) update process. The report outlined the input from nearly two years of consultations with staff and the public and recommended next steps for updating the OP.

During the summer of 2012 the PACAC organized an ad-hoc committee to research and make a submission to the Planning Division calling for support of heritage preservation in the OP review. In September of 2012 the committee submitted a 10 page document summarizing a review of the heritage content of numerous Official Plans and outlining recommendations for the Peterborough OP.

In addition, in an update report presented in April 2012, the Planning Division had noted that key values or recommendations from ongoing or recently completed City strategic plans, including the Municipal Cultural Plan (MCP), should be reflected in the OP review. Based on that recommendation, the PACAC also developed input for the OP review process in order to facilitate plan alignment between the OP and the MCP.

Brad Appleby, the Planner of Subdivision Control and Special Projects will provide the PACAC with an update on how the PACAC submission is being incorporated into the OP review and how the process will proceed based on the March 4, 2013 presentation to Council.
