Subject:	Report PACAC14-022 Heritage Hunt Funding Request

Purpose

A report to request additional funding in support of reprinting the Heritage Hunt as a fold out rack card for promotional and educational purposes.

Recommendation

That the Peterborough Architectural Conservation Advisory Committee approve the recommendation outlined in Report PACAC14-022, dated June 5, 2014 of the Heritage Resources Coordinator, as follows:

That the PACAC approve the expenditure of \$300.00 from the existing Heritage Hunt budget to reformat and print 500 copies of the Hunt as a fold out rack card to be made available at the Visitor Centre and other tourist locations.

Budget and Financial Implications

The \$300.00 funding request can be accommodated within the approved \$2,300.00 allocation for the 2014 Heritage Hunt.

Background

The 2014 Heritage Hunt was published in the April 4th edition of *Peterborough This Week*. Some 250 additional copies were printed and distributed to sponsors and relevant community locations. The Hunt generated quite a bit of interest in the community, with more than 25 official submissions received. Feedback from previous years suggests that only about 1 in 10 people to take part in the event actually submit an entry for a prize. Staff believes that a reformatted version of the Hunt could be used as a promotional tool to raise awareness of Peterborough's architectural heritage amongst visitors to the city.

At its meeting of November 14, 2013, the PACAC approved a budget of \$1,500.00 for the Heritage Hunt to cover the costs associated with coordination and publicity. An ad-hoc committee was also struck for the purpose of coordinating the Hunt for 2014. This committee has since raised \$800 in sponsorships to support costs related to the event. The additional funding has generated a surplus in the budget that will accommodate the additional funding request.
