## **Purpose**

A report to recommend that a sub-committee be struck to coordinate a special event to commemorate the 40<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of PACAC.

## **Recommendation**

That the PACAC approve the recommendation outlined in Report PACAC14-026, dated September 4, 2014 of the Heritage Resources Coordinator, as follows:

That a sub-committee of PACAC, including alumni, be struck to coordinate a special event to commemorate the 40<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the committee, and that this event include the launch of the publication in honour of Martha Kidd.

## **Budget and Financial Implications**

Costs associated with this initiative can be accommodated through a combination of fundraising, sales of PACAC merchandise, and the utilisation of budgetary funds committed to the implementation of a launch event of the publication in honour of Martha Kidd.

## **Background**

The Peterborough Architectural Conservation Advisory Committee (PACAC) was formally established on June 2, 1975 through the passage by City Council By-law Number 1975-112 (Appendix A). Since that time, the PACAC has played an active role in the preservation and commemoration of the heritage of Peterborough. A special event to commemorate the 40<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the PACAC would provide an opportunity to recognize the Committee's many achievements over four decades, as well as the service of a number of Peterborough citizens in support of its legislated mandate. An event of this nature would also help to raise awareness about the continued relevance of the PACAC to the protection and promotion of Peterborough's rich built and cultural heritage.
