BY-LAW NUMBER 1975- 112

A BY-LAW TO ESTABLISH A LOCAL ARCHITECTURAL CONSERVATION ADVISORY COMMITTEE

WHEREAS The Ontario Heritage Act. 1974, provides that the council of a municipality may, by by-law, establish a local advisory committee to be known as the Local Architectural Conservation Advisory Committee composed of not fewer than five members appointed by the council to advise and assist the council on all matters relating to parts IV and V of the said Act.

NOW THEREFORE THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF PETERBOROUGH BY THE COUNCIL THEREOF ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. A Local Architectural Conservation Advisory Committee be and it is hereby established under the provisions of the Ontario Heritage Act, 1974.

2. The Committee shall be composed of nine persons appointed by the Council of the Corporation of the City of Peterborough who are ratepayers of the City of Peterborough, one of whom shall be a member of the said Council.

3. The members of the Committee shall be appointed to the thirty-first day of December, 1975, except the member of Council who shall be appointed to the thirty-first day of December, 1976, and who thereafter shall hold office for a term of two years from the first day of January in which he or she is appointed.

4. The remaining members of the Committee shall hold office for three years except that in the case of the members appointed on the first day of January, 1976, two shall hold office for a term of one year, three for a term of two years and three for a term of three years from that date.

5. Every member of the Committee shall continue in office until his successor is appointed and any member of the Committee whose term of office has expired shall be eligible for re-appointment.

6. City Council shall make all necessary appointments to the Committee at the first meeting of the Council in each year, except for the appointment of the member of Council.

7. City Council shall, as often as the office of a member of the Committee becomes vacant, either by resignation, death or ineligibility, appoint a successor thereto who shall hold office for the remainder of the unexpired portion of the term of the said member who has resigned, died or become ineligible.

8. There shall be a Chairman and Vice-Chairman who shall be elected annually at the first meeting of the Committee and those shall be the only officers of the Committee.
9. It shall be the duty of the Committee to advise and assist City Council on all matters relating to parts IV and V of the Heritage Act of Ontario, 1974.

10. Prior to the thirtieth day of November of each year, the Committee shall present a request to Council for any necessary funding for the subsequent year and advise Council with respect to any proposed capital expenditures.

11. The Committee shall report to City Council not later than the twenty-eighth day of February of each year with respect to the operation and function of the Committee all aspects of the conservation, protection and preservation of the heritage of the City of Peterborough.
