Update on PACAC 40th Anniversary Activities

Purpose

A report to advise the PACAC on the activities planned to celebrate the 40th Anniversary of the Committee's establishment.

Recommendation

That the Peterborough Architectural Conservation Advisory Committee approve the recommendation outlined in Report PACAC16-017, dated May 7, 2015 of the Heritage Resources Coordinator, as follows:

Budget and Financial Implications

There are no budgetary or financial implications associated with the recommendation.

Background

June 2, 2015 marks the 40th anniversary of the creation of the Peterborough Architectural Conservation Advisory Committee. On September 4, 2014 the Committee created an ad-hoc sub-committee to explore possible ways to celebrate 40 years of heritage preservation in Peterborough. On February 15, 2015 the Committee approved a recommendation to provide a budget of up to \$10,000 for project coordination and publicity associated with the Committee's 40th anniversary.

The sub-committee has met several times and several projects are being considered for the summer and fall of 2015:

A 'birthday party' on or near the date of passage of the by-law. The party might take be a public barbeque but would include special invitations to owners of designated heritage properties. The event could include a market area for businesses providing heritage trades or products.

A Heritage Homes dinner which would be hosted in, and by, owners of designated heritage homes. The event would be held on two consecutive weekends and the dinners would be catered by local businesses. The proceeds from the sale of tickets would be presented as a donation to a heritage organization in the City.

The production and sale of prints and other commemorative material based on the design work Ron Thom created for the revitalization of Peterborough in the 1960s.
