World Town Planning Day Presentation

Purpose

Background

Every year planners around the world engage in activities to raise awareness of the importance of planning in their communities. Planners in about 30 countries mark World Town Planning Day by talking to community and student groups or sponsoring activities that highlight the importance of planning. Planners also visit local high schools, participate in student events at universities, hold public open houses and displays, and sponsor events.

One such event was held on January 28, 2016, sponsored by the Rotary Club of Peterborough in partnership with the Lakelands District of the Ontario Professional Planners Institute. The goal of the event was to introduce university and college students and young professionals to community planning and development as they worked side by side with local planners, architects and other professionals.

The purpose of this report is to introduce this annual event and provide a forum for the results of the session to be presented in a Council setting.
