Being a By-law to extend the interim control provisions of By-law 14-016 for the City of Peterborough to prohibit the issuance of permits for electronic signs until March 4, 2015 to allow for the completion of further review

KNOW ALL MEN subsection 38 (2) of the *Planning Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c. P.13, as amended, permits the Council of a municipality to extend the period of an interim control by-law in effect where the Council has directed that a review or study be undertaken in respect of land use planning policies within the municipality or in any defined area or areas of thereof;

5 bX'K\ YfYUg Council of the Corporation of the City of Peterborough deems it appropriate to extend the enactment of such interim control by-law;

5 bX'K\ YfYUg further consultation and research is necessary in order to determine the appropriate regulations for Electronic Signs in the City of Peterborough;

Bck 'H YfYZfY, The Corporation of the City of Peterborough by the Council thereof hereby enacts as follows:

1. For the purposes of this interim control by-law, "Electronic Sign" shall be a sign with intermittent lighting in the form of letters, numerals or pictures as defined by the City's Sign By-law No. 02-045, Chapter 624 of the City of Peterborough Municipal Code. '
2. While this by-law is in force and effect no permits shall be issued for electronic signs within the municipal boundaries of the City of Peterborough.'
3. This By-law shall be in force and effect for a four month period commencing October 4, 2014 through to March 4, 2015. '

By-law read a first, second and third time this 29th day of September, 2014.
