4. Reports/Updates

a) Biosolids Management Strategy

Chairperson Heath introduced Mr. Vincent Nazareth of R.V. Anderson Associates Limited who provided a presentation an overview of the Peterborough Biosolids Options Technical Memorandum #2.

b) 2009 Landfill Odour Survey Report

Ms. Kawalec provided a brief overview of the 2009 Landfill Odour Survey Report, prepared by RWDI. Ms. Kawalec advised the Committee that this report will be used by the Waste Operations Coordinator to provide direction on the site maintenance and repair work plan. The large majority of the higher odour areas have already be repaired. This is the second year for this report, which staff anticipate completing annually for odour management purposes.

c) 2008 Design and Operations Report

Ms. Kawalec advised the Committee that the 2008 Design and Operations Report for the Peterborough Waste Management Facility is available and posted on the City’s web for review. UEM and Golder and Associates are scheduled to provide a summary of the annual report at the Site Liaison Committee meeting scheduled for July 7, 2009.

Ms. Kawalec noted that the private well sampling schedule for a number of the houses surrounding the landfill site ended in 2008. Ms. Kawalec suggested, and the Committee concurred that the sampling of private wells should continue on based on the historical schedule. Staff will continue to ensure compliance with the SHAME and local township agreements.

c) Status of National Grocer Development

Ms. Kawalec address Councillor Vass question regarding the old National Grocers Site for development of a Material Recycling Facility. Ms. Kawalec noted that staffs believe there is still interest in this property for development; to staff knowledge there is no new information to report. Ms. Kawalec has been in contact with the Ministry representative regarding approval and zoning. It is noted that approval will not be processed without re-zoning has been completed by City Staff.
