SUBJECT: Report WMC13-012
Technical Standards and Safety Authority Inspection of
Peterborough County/City Waste Management Facility

PURPOSE

A report to provide information on an inspection of the Peterborough County/City Waste Management Facility (the "Landfill") undertaken by a representative of the Technical Standards and Safety Authority ("TSSA").

RECOMMENDATION

That the Waste Management Committee endorse the recommendation as outlined in Report WMC13-012 dated June 24, 2013, of the Director of Utility Services as follows:

That Report WMC13-012 dated June 24, 2013 providing information on an inspection of the Peterborough County/City Waste Management Facility undertaken by a representative of the Technical Standards and Safety Authority be received for information.

BUDGET AND FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

There are no budget or financial implications to receiving this report for information. A further report will be submitted indicating costs associated with undertaking the requirements of TSSA.

BACKGROUND

An unscheduled inspection of the Landfill site was completed by a representative of TSSA on May 29, 2013. The resultant inspection report (No. 4490043) is attached as Appendix A.

The first 6 pages of the report detail 13 Orders that must be complied with. The following 5 pages provide a summary of the actual inspection procedure while the last 4 pages are copies of various forms to be used when clearing the Orders.

It is important to note the inspection report states "...no immediate hazards were identified during inspection of the facility conducted on May 28, 2013."

Next Steps

The consultant for the Landfill has been requested to review the Orders and provide guidance on the next steps necessary for resolution. To satisfy some of the Orders will require submission of supporting documents. To satisfy others will require upgrades to existing facilities.

Upon completion of the consultant's task, staff will be in a better position to estimate required work and costs. It is expected that this information will be available for submission to the September meeting of the Waste Management Committee.
