Housing Division and Social Services Update

Purpose

A report to introduce a presentation from the Housing Policy Analyst, Infrastructure and Planning Services with the City of Peterborough.

Recommendation

That the Accessibility Advisory Committee (AAC) approve the recommendation outlined in Report AAC18-035 dated October 3, 2018, of the Accessibility and Communication Specialist as follows:

Budget and Financial Implications

There are no budgetary or financial implications associated with the recommendation.

Background

The Housing Services Act 2011, requires the City of Peterborough, in its role as Service Manager, to have a 10-year Housing and Homelessness Plan (the "Plan"). The Plan was approved by City Council and endorsed by the County in 2014.

Service Managers are also required to review and update their plans at least once every five years. The deadline of submission of the amended plan to the Ministry of Housing is June 30, 2019.

A key element of the 5-year review of the Plan includes reaching out to the community through consultations. The Accessibility Advisory Committee is an important partner to include in the consultation process to ensure that the accessibility needs of the community are reflected in the revised Housing and Homelessness Plan.
