Purpose

Background

Dr. Michael Eamon is the Co-Chair of Trent University's Heritage Stewardship Committee. Leading up to Trent's 50th anniversary, the committee led a process to raise aware about the unique heritage of the University. In conjunction with the heritage-consulting firm ARA, the University has undertaken an inventory of its heritage resources and produced a Heritage Stewardship Policy (attached as Appendix A). ARA also undertook a Cultural Heritage Evaluation Report of the Bata Library in advance of renovations on that Library which are currently nearing completion. Dr. Eamon will give a presentation on the policy, the inventory, and the Bata Library.
