Background

The Peterborough Drug Strategy Task Force was established in April 2009 by the Peterborough County City Health Unit, Peterborough Aids Resource Network, Peterborough Lakefield Community Police Service, and Four Counties Addiction Services. The Peterborough Drug Strategy (PDS) is a collective that unites stakeholders in Peterborough City and County to develop collaborative solutions to minimize the harms of substance use for individuals, families and our community.

The PDS works to improve health, safety, and well being of citizens with an approach based on the four pillars of prevention, harm reduction, enforcement and treatment.
