The Architect has responded to PACAC's letter as follows:

"We welcome the comments from the PACAC as we've put a lot of consideration into how the new building will fit in with the existing King George while establishing its own identity.

Some points to note:

- The brick and stone used in the new building will be a close match to the materials of the existing school
- The south block of the new school echoes the massing of the existing building
- The south block will have a stone band and an contemporary interpretation of the deep cornice on the existing building.
- The north block will have a more contemporary vocabulary, more in line with the museum and archives building.

I can include the points above in our response with the 2nd submission. The materials used are noted on the exterior elevations.
