Heritage Conservation District Signage

Purpose

A report to provide information to the PACAC on the current status of signage for the Heritage Conservation District.

Budget and Financial Implications

There are no budgetary or financial implications associated with the recommendation.

Background

In November 2016, the PACAC recommended that a capital allocation request be made for the provision of affinity signage in the Avenues and Neighbourhood Conservation District. Many municipalities identify the boundaries of heritage conservation district with affinity signage.

In 2019, a capital budget allocation of \$25,000 was made for this signage. Staff are currently researching options for the HCD signage including design, procurement, installation logistics and accessibility.
