Purpose

Budget and Financial Implications

Background

Outstanding Designations: There are currently 9 outstanding heritage designation requests from the public. Staff are working to complete research and prepare designation briefs for these properties.

MMC Student Exhibition: The opening for the Museum Management and Curatorship students' exhibition at the Peterborough Museum and Archives will take place on Thursday April 18, from 2 p.m. to 4 p.m.

MMC Intern – The HPO will again be hosting an intern from the Museum Management and Curatorship program at Fleming College. The student will continue work on populating the walking tour with sites and stories with a focus on the history of music in Peterborough.

Nominations for the PHS Annual Heritage Awards - The PHS sponsors annual Heritage Awards for citizens of Peterborough City and County to recognize outstanding accomplishments in heritage preservation and promotion. Two awards in particular, the George Cox Award and the Martha Kidd Award recognize excellence in heritage preservation. The deadline for nominations is Friday, 12 April. The application is attached as Appendix A of this report.

Façade Improvement Program- Three downtown buildings have made application for the first round of grant funding for façade improvements. HPO staff will provide details once applications have been reviewed.
