Background

The Career Ready Fund, a provincial funding opportunity helps publicly assisted colleges and universities, employers and other organizations to create experiential learning opportunities for postsecondary students and recent graduates. Fleming College received \$350,000 from the Career Ready Fund through the Career Kick-Start Strategy funding stream.

With the funding, Fleming College launched several new initiatives including a cultivation of tools to support accessibility in placement sites. A smoother transition to accommodate accessible experiential learning for students with disabilities, assisted students in completing this component of their desired programs.
