Background

Library Commons Sculpture

The construction of the sculpture for the Library Commons is well underway. The sculpture is being manufactured by North on Sixty in modules. The units will be transported to site nested on a truck bed and installed using a crane.

The sculpture installation timing is contingent on further construction work on the Library Commons site. Project lead, Gillian Barnes is working closely with us to ensure the site contractor will work around the art installation. The expected completion of the entire project is late June or early July.
