## **Purpose**

A report to advise Council that a public meeting will be held Wednesday, May 22, 2019 at 6:00 pm, to hear public delegations on the 2020 Budget Guideline Report.

# **Budget and Financial Implications**

There are no budget or financial implications to receiving the report. A report will be presented to the June 10, 2019 Finance Committee containing specific recommendations for the 2020 Budget Guideline Report and addressing issues that may arise during the May 22, 2019 public meeting.

# **Background**

A public meeting will be held on May 22, 2019 at 6:00 pm, during which staff will present a 2020 Budget Guideline Report (a preliminary version is attached as Appendix A). Members of the public will then have an opportunity to make presentations or comment to Council about the proposed Guidelines. They may also take the opportunity to comment on other aspects of the City's Operating and Capital Budgets that are not specifically addressed in the Guideline Report.

The public meeting follows a series of informal Ward meeting and drop-in style events that discussed among other things, the 2020 Budget and Budget Survey. A summary of the dates and location of the public engagement opportunities surrounding the 2020 Budget Guideline Report are as follows:
