Township of Douro-Dummer Decision re
Police Services

Purpose

A report to advise Council that the Township of Douro-Dummer has decided to enter into a contract with the Ontario Provincial Police to provide police services to the Township.

Recommendation

That Council approve the recommendation outlined in Report CAO19-005, dated June 10, 2019, of the Chief Administrative Officer, as follows:

That the report advising Council that the Township of Douro-Dummer has decided to enter into a contract with the Ontario Provincial Police to provide police services to the Township for the next four years be received for information.

Budget and Financial Implications

There are no budget and financial implications to receive this report.

Background

The Township of Douro-Dummer (Township) asked the City of Peterborough and the Peterborough Police Service if they had an interest in providing a policing quote for the Township for a four year period or longer. The Township's contract with the Ontario Provincial Police expired December 31, 2018.

Council, through Report CAO19-003, dated April 8, 2019, directed staff to enter into discussions with the Township.

However, on May 8, 2019 the CAO of the Township sent a letter to the CAO (attached as Appendix A) stating that the Township has decided to enter into a contract with the OPP for the next 4 years.
