Accessibility Review

a) 1030 Lansdowne Street West

Summary of recommendations from the Built Environment Sub-Committee:

- 1. Ensure there is an accessible parking space for the existing building that is located close to the entrance and pedestrian walkway.
- 2. Ensure proper lighting throughout the site
- 3. Ensure any walkways do not have a slope of more than 5%
- 4. Include a walkway network to define pedestrian/worker space and vehicular space. Important to define pedestrian/worker space for overall safety.
- 5. Include a walkway network that connects to current building
- 6. Limestone screening rather than gravel
