**Winter Control Services Agreement between the City and the County of Peterborough**

---

## **Purpose**

A report to recommend the renewal of the winter control services agreement between the City of Peterborough and the County of Peterborough.

## **Recommendations**

That Council approve the recommendations outlined in Report IPSENG19-036, dated October 7, 2019 of the Commissioner of Infrastructure and Planning Services, as follows:

- a) That Council approve a winter control services agreement between the City of Peterborough and the County of Peterborough on terms and conditions set out in Report IPSENG19-036; and
- b) That the Commissioner, Infrastructure and Planning Services, be authorized to execute such documents to effect the said agreement in forms acceptable to the City Solicitor.

## **Budget and Financial Implications**

There are no budget or financial implications to accepting the recommendations of this report. Operating budgets make allowance of the winter control services outlined within this report.

## Background

### Brief Description of the Work

Municipal boundaries intersect a number of road segments that dictate the road authority changes at internal points to those road segments. In order to streamline services in both a productive and cost-effective manner the County of Peterborough and the City of Peterborough agree to perform winter control services on a shared portion of each others road segments at various boundary locations.

Currently there are approximately nine kilometres of boundary road that is subject to this agreement. Both the City and the County of Peterborough provide winter control services for approximately 4.5 kilometres of the other organization's roads. The responsibilities include winter control services in accordance with the standards contained in Ontario Regulation 239/02 made under the **Municipal Act**, Minimum Maintenance Standards for Municipal Highways.

The renewed agreement would extend for a five year term.

### Timelines

If the recommendations are approved, the agreement will be finalized in consultation with the City Solicitor and signed by the Commissioner, under the delegated authority provided.

It is proposed the agreement would take effect from November 1, 2019 to October 31, 2024.

## Summary

A renewed five year winter control services agreement is recommended between the City of Peterborough and the County of Peterborough to provide reciprocal winter control services on boundary roads.
