Climate Change Discussion

Purpose

A report to recommend that the PEAC advise on additional potential actions for the community focused strategies in the Climate Change Action Plan (CCAP) and discuss adaptation strategies.

Recommendation

That the PEAC approve the recommendation outlined in Report PEAC20-005 dated February 19, 2020 of the Manager of Infrastructure Management Division, as follows:

Budget and Financial Implications

There are no budgetary or financial implications associated with the recommendation.

Background

At its meeting of January 22, 2020, the PEAC received an update on actions in the CCAP targeting community sector emissions. Several members of PEAC expressed the desire to discuss additional potential actions that could be considered.

In addition to discussing mitigation activities, a balanced approach to responding to climate change requires considering both mitigation (actions to reduce greenhouse gas emissions that contribute to climate change) and adaptation (actions to manage the impacts of climate change). Impacts that will likely be experienced in the City of Peterborough in the coming decades include, an increase in intensity and frequency of precipitation events, warmer temperatures and longer dry periods, and increasing climate variability and extremes. These impacts and potential responses will be discussed.
